IT IS BECAUSE THINGS IN THE WORLD REPRESENT IDEAS THAT WE HAVE ACCESS, THROUGH THE MIND (BUT WITH EFFORT), TO THE PERFECTION THAT BELONGS TO THE IDEAL REALM – TO TRUE GOODS (LIKE ACTUAL JUSTICE, THINGS WE NOW VALUE & SUPPOSE WE HAVE BUT MAY NOT HAVE) & TO THE GOOD (THE SOURCE OF ALL BEAUTY, TRUTH, & GOOD)

PROPOSITION **27**



WE ARE **INCLINED** BY OUR NATURE TO TAKE **SHADOWS** & **IMAGES** (BOTH INHERENTLY SECONDARY) AS REALITY - TO ACCEPT BOTH THE WORLD OF SENSE EXPERIENCE & THAT OF OPINIONS (OUR OWN & THOSE WE ARE INVITED TO HOLD BY OTHERS) AS REAL WITHOUT MOVING TO ENQUIRE (TO HAVE CONTACT WITH REALITY FOR OURSELVES)

PROPOSITION **28**



SEEING THIS ULTIMATE REALITY IS A BEATIFIC VISION, A VISION OF BLESSEDNESS:

IT IS A **VISION:** THE *GLORY* OF SUPREME REALITIES (JUSTICE, TRUTH, THE GOOD, AS THEY ARE) REGISTERED BY THE **NOUS** (EYES OF THE SOUL);

IT IS A VISION OF BLESSEDNESS: AN ENCOUNTER THAT DOES NOT SIMPLY IMPART KNOWLEDGE BUT IS WISDOM: I.E., AN ACTIVE EXPERIENCE OF AWE, LOVE, HAPPINESS, RECEPTION OF WHAT THE VISION ENTAILS
